solutionary

Activity: Get your learners to challenge their peers solutions and try to improve them.

Activity: Get your learners to discuss what risks are involved with their solution and how they can be minimised.

a person who solves a problem and shares it with others.

Activity: Get your learners to discuss how other businesses or organisations can use their solutions.

awarious

(noun)

a person who is curiously aware, always learning.

Activity: Get your learners to take their learning out of the classroom. For example get them to feedback what they have learned with their family or a professional.
